ANNUAL TUITION FEE – Middle School (Yr7–8, Age 12–14)	R105 661
ANNUAL TUITION FEE – High School (IGCSE and AS Age 15–18)	R117 369

Included in the fees: Tuition Fees are inclusive of all innings, outings, compulsory sport, wifi and printing at school, teaching resources, a daily cooked lunch and annual family membership to BSA.

There are 3 options with regard to the payment of tuition fees:

- 1. Monthly payments:** payable over 10 months (due on the first day of each month, January to October)
- 2. Termly fees:** payable on the 1st day of the first 3 terms of the year as follows:
Term 1 – 50% of the total fees | Term 2 – 25 % of the total fees | Term 3 – The balance of the fees owed.
- 3. Upfront payment:** A 6.25% discount on the tuition fee is applied to fees paid by 15th November 2025 and a 5% discount is applied to fees paid by 15th January 2026.

Uniform: Evolve Academy T-Shirt, Fleece and Cap are compulsory items to be worn for sport and outings.

Textbooks and stationery: Parents are responsible for the purchase of textbooks which support the curriculum and exercise books and stationery items as per list provided by 1 October each year.

External examinations: Parents are responsible for the cost of all external examination fees for IG2 and AS.

Devices and software: Middle school students require access to a computer at home for projects and homework. High school students are required to bring a laptop operating Windows. The device's administration rights are required to be signed over to the school for management purposes. Devices are brought to school at own risk. Device specifications will be provided.

Additional obligatory incidental fees: Other costs that you may incur include: IGCSE Art & Design student supplies, remedial specialists, facilitators, invigilators, technology devices and software, calculators, elective extra-mural activities, elective meals, camps, workshops, career advisement assessments, bus transport, additional uniform, school photographs, aftercare, holiday care.

Notice: One full term's notice (3 months) of intent to leave the School must be given in writing by the 1st day of the term, or pay a full term's fees in lieu of notice. Notice must be sent to the admin@evolveacademy.co.za. Families who withdraw before Term 4 but pay fees on a 10-month schedule will not receive a refund or pro rata adjustment across 12 months.

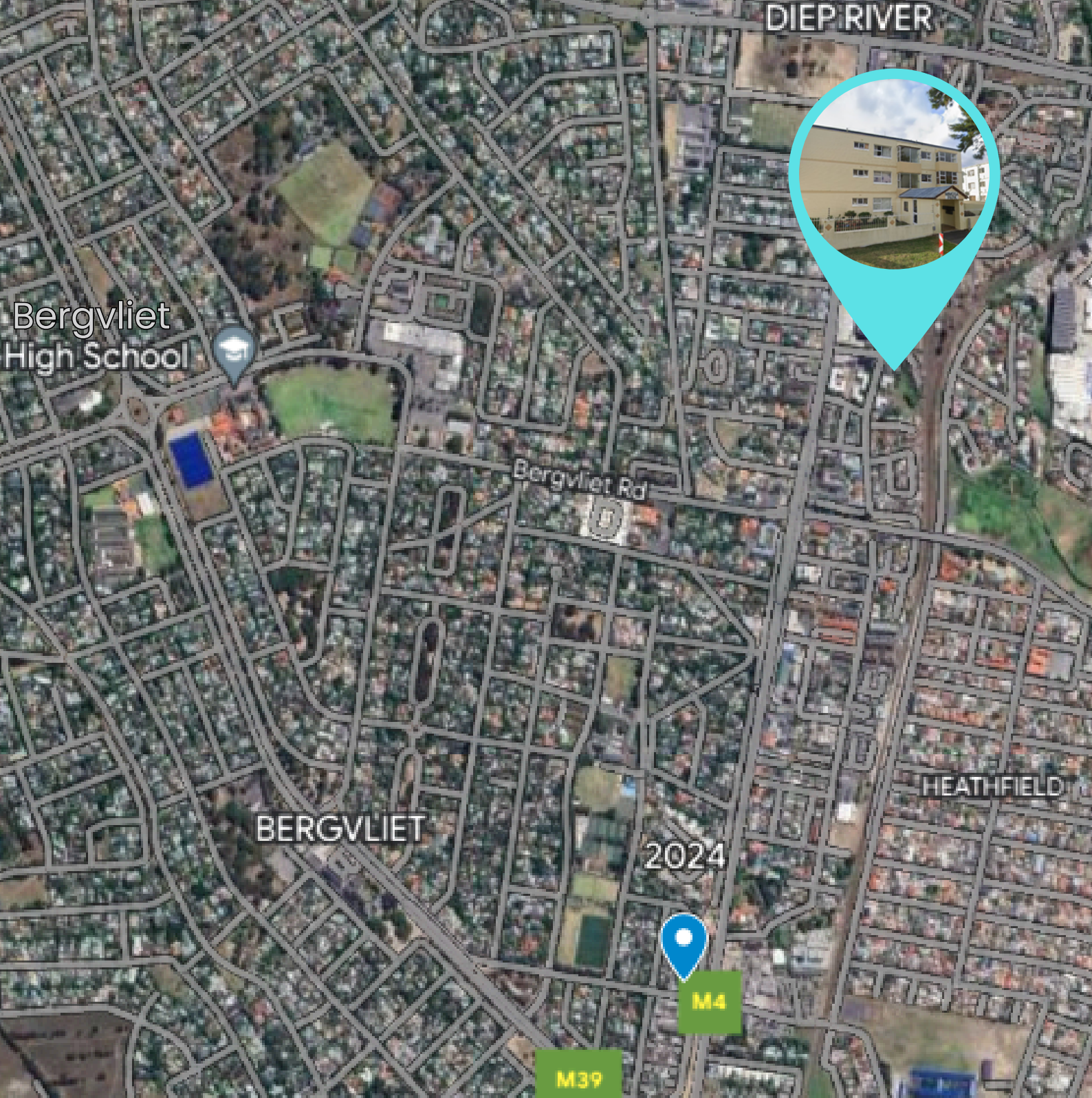
